# Q10 Indiana County, as in much of the nation, is experiencing an opioid/heroin epidemic. What are your thoughts on how to address this issue?





### Q13 What age(s) is (are) the child(ren)?





### Q14 If yes to question 8, does the child live with you?







# Q19 What priority do you think should be given during the next five years to programs in Indiana County that...

















# Q32 Do you have a disability that prevents you from doing your own daily living activities?










